- Tour members travel to one of U.S. and Canada ICELANDAIR gateways to Iceland and check in for their flight.

- Drive east through southern Iceland to Landeyjahöfn. Board ferry Herjólfur for the 30-minute crossing to the Westman Islands.
- Check in at 3-star Hótel Vestmannaeyjar, the best hotel in town – for a 3-night stay.
- Meet & Mix in the lounge. John Chumack lays out the plans for the days to come.






August 09 (Mon.) In the Westman Islands

- Morning excursion of Heimaey, the main Island, with local tour guide Eybór Björgvinsson. Visit Eldfell, the volcano that caused the destruction of much of the town in 1973. Heimaey had to be evacuated and about 400 houses were buried in lava and ash. The island has been called "The Pompeii of the North" ever since.
- Visit Eldheimar, the spectacular Volcano Museum. The displays are centered on an excavated home which was buried by ash during the eruption. The audio guides are excellent and provide you with a true sense of the dramatic history of Heimaey.
- Tour the world's only Beluga Whale & Puffin Sanctuary. Enjoy a boat excursion across Klettsvík Bay and meet Beluga Whales "Little White" and "Little Grey."
- Dinner at "Gott" Restaurant. Enjoy the best of Icelandic lamb, - a delicacy.
- > 1st day of photography with John Chumack.
- Days are long this time of the year in Iceland

August 10 (Tue.) On Heimaey


- > Full day of photography.
- Drive to Lyngfell Horse Farm to photograph and pet the Icelandic horses. You can also take a short ride, if you like. The Icelandic Horses are loved and admired by all visitors to Iceland. The Icelandic breed is one of the purest in the world. It is known for its amazing strength, surefootedness and stamina. It was first brought to Iceland by the Vikings who settled the country in the years 874-930.
- Your tour vehicle will be at the ready at all times to head for the best vantage points on the island, such as Elephant Rock.
- Dinner at Einsi Kaldi. You are in for a special treat, - the best of Westman Island Cuisine.

Iceland offers an abundance of fresh sea-food and the Westman Islands are known for its selection of excellent restaurants, which is amazing, considering its small (4500) population. You're sure to enjoy some of the best fish and lobster dishes of your life.

Einsi Kaldi, owner and master chef of the restaurant will prepare a feast that you may find somewhat unusual, fascinating, but indeed, - delicious.



August 11 (Wed.) Off - to the mainland

- Leave Westman Islands by the morning ferry.
- Visit two of Iceland's most beautiful waterfalls; Skógafoss and Seljalandsfoss.
- Proceed to the wilds of Iceland in **Þórsmörk**, a valley hidden between three glaciers an adventure expediton.
- > Buffet lunch at Básar in the middle of Þórsmörk.
- > Check in at cozy Hótel Lækur for a 2-night stay.
- Dinner at Hótel Lækur; another meal to remember.



SELJALANDSFOSS

Pórsmörk is a nature reserve named after Þór (Thor) the Viking God of Thunder. You reach this spectacular area by crossing lava fields and un-bridged glacial rivers, an exhilarating but safe experience.

August 12 (Thu.) Famous Gullfoss & Geysir

- Depart on an excursion to include some of the major natural attractions in Iceland.
- Drive north to Gulfoss, the majestic waterfall that spans the Hvítá River and sprays mist on those who come near to marvel at its beauty.
- A short drive to the west takes us to the **Geysir** geothermal area, where a number of boiling, bubbling and spouting hot springs are seen in an eerie moonlike landscape. Visit **Geysir**, which all geysers are named after. Though it rarely erupts, nearby **Strokkur** keeps the show alive, erupting every 4-8 minutes.
- Drive on to Friðheimar Farm, an amazing greenhouse & horse-breeding complex. Gain an insight to the uses of geothermal heating in Iceland. Savor a unique food experience, tomato soup and fresh baked bread, with tomatoes growing all around you.

After lunch, enjoy a **horse show** that provides an under-standing of the remarkable Icelandic horse breed. The display is followed by a "Meeting with the Horses" in their stables.

Return to Hótel Lækur for another scrumptious dinner. You might also like to enjoy the hot pot.

August 13 (Fri.) Off to Reykjavík

- Drive to Reykjavík, the colorful and lively capital of Iceland (56 miles).
- Enjoy a 2-hour City Tour of Reykjavík with a local tour guide. First visit Hallgrímskirkja, the tallest and largest church in Iceland and a prominent landmark. The church is of distinctive Icelandic design, dedicated to the most revered, sacred poet of Iceland, Hallgrímur Pétursson.

A statue of **Leif** (Leifur) **Eriksson** is aligned directly in front of the church. It was a gift from the U.S. to commemorate the 1000th anniversary of the foundation of the Icelandic parliament., a tacit acknowledgement that Leif beat Christopher Columbus to North America by almost 500 years

You will enjoy the view of the city from the top of the water tanks that feed the city with hot water. Drive by the University of Iceland, the Parliament, National Theater and **Harpa**, the new Concert Hall. Drive through residential areas and the harbor where older buildings have been retrofitted as boutiques and restaurants.

- Check in at Hótel Plaza, located on Íngólfstorg, the main square in the heart of the "old city," with restaurants, shopping and nightlife on your doorstep.
- Farewell to Iceland" dinner is served at **Geysir Bistro** located just around the corner from your hotel.

August 14 (Sat.) In Reykjavík

- Free day in Reykjavík.
- Lunch and dinner on your own,
- Suggested optional features:

Morning: Visit the Whale Museum followed by a 5hour Whale Watching Excursion. Cruise Faxaflói Bay on a comfortable boat. The most common species in the winter is the White-Beaked Dolphin, the Harbor Porpoise as well as Minke and Humpback Whale. The winter cruises also offer opportunities to see many seabirds that call Iceland home, such as guillemots, gannets, cormorants & eider ducks. \$140

Lunch: Visit one of the downtown hot dog stands for eina með öllu (one with everything). You will be right back for more. The Icelandic hot dogs are delicious; contain a secret mix of pork, beef and lamb.

Afternoon: A 3-hour excursion to Pingvellir, the national shrine of Iceland, - the site of the ancient Icelandic Parliament, and a meeting point of the continental plates, a geological phenomenon. Þingvellir is a designated UNESCO Heritage Site.

Evening: Enjoy a musical performance at Harpa, the new and magnificent culture center. Program information will be available in the summer of 2020.
